Re: **2016 John & Doretta Gillott | Florida Gulf Coast Chapter
Educational Scholarship**

At the January, 2004 meeting of the board of directors, the Florida Gulf Coast Chapter Board approved the establishment of the *John & Doretta Gillott | Florida Gulf Coast Chapter Education Scholarship* program. The scholarship was created to promote educational opportunities for Candidates of the chapter and to recognize the Gillotts' long-standing commitment to, and involvement with, the Florida Gulf Coast Chapter education program.

This year, the board approved the funding of one scholarship for 2016, equivalent to the cost of a chapter-sponsored Appraisal Institute (QE) qualifying education core course. John and Doretta Gillott have again offered to fund an additional scholarship, for a total of two scholarships.

Attached you will find the guidelines for the scholarship, as well as an application. Please note that the request for consideration must be accompanied by a letter of recommendation from a Florida Gulf Coast Chapter designated member.

Applications for this year's scholarships are due to the chapter office via mail, fax (813-962-4006) or e-mail (wcoastfl@tampabay.rr.com) by **May 1, 2016**. The Board of Directors will consider all applications and make a decision on the recipients at the May board meeting. Recipients will have two years to utilize the scholarship on a Florida Gulf Coast chapter-sponsored course (seminars are not included).

JOHN & DORETTA GILLOTT | FLORIDA GULF COAST CHAPTER EDUCATION SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- Purpose:** To promote educational opportunities for Candidates of the Florida Gulf Coast Chapter of the Appraisal Institute (FGC Chapter, AI), while recognizing two individuals (Doretta and John Gillott), who have provided significant contributions to the chapter educational program.
- Use:** Scholarship can be applied **ONLY** to Florida Gulf Coast chapter-sponsored, Appraisal Institute core courses qualifying an individual towards the MAI or SRA designations.
- Amount:** Equivalent to the cost of a 4-day chapter-sponsored Appraisal Institute core course. The Gillotts have agreed to match the chapter-funded scholarship, which will result in the awarding of two scholarships.
- Eligibility:** Candidates in good standing with the FGC Chapter, AI. Candidates must show previous participation in chapter activities, including attendance at chapter quarterly meetings, chapter-sponsored educational offerings, service on chapter committees and active pursuance of designation.
- Required:** Completed application with a letter of recommendation from an MAI, SRA or SRPA member of the FGC Chapter, AI.
- Deadline:** Applications for 2016 must be received by **May 1, 2016**.
- Award Determination:** Officers and Directors of the Florida Gulf Coast Chapter to select recipients at the 2nd Quarter board of directors meeting. Scholarships must be utilized within two years of being awarded.

Maximum number of awards per Candidate – 2

The Florida Gulf Coast Chapter of the Appraisal Institute reserves the right to choose the award recipient(s). Award decisions cannot be appealed to national Appraisal Institute representatives. Application material will be considered confidential. Application material will not be returned to the applicant. Applicants will be notified if they have been selected as a scholarship recipient and presented with a certificate that will need to be presented when registering for a course. Note – If scholarship recipient needs only an advanced course that the chapter does not plan to offer, the chapter will reimburse the scholarship recipient a maximum of \$450 with proof of successful completion of the course and exam. (Expires: 2 years from date of award)
